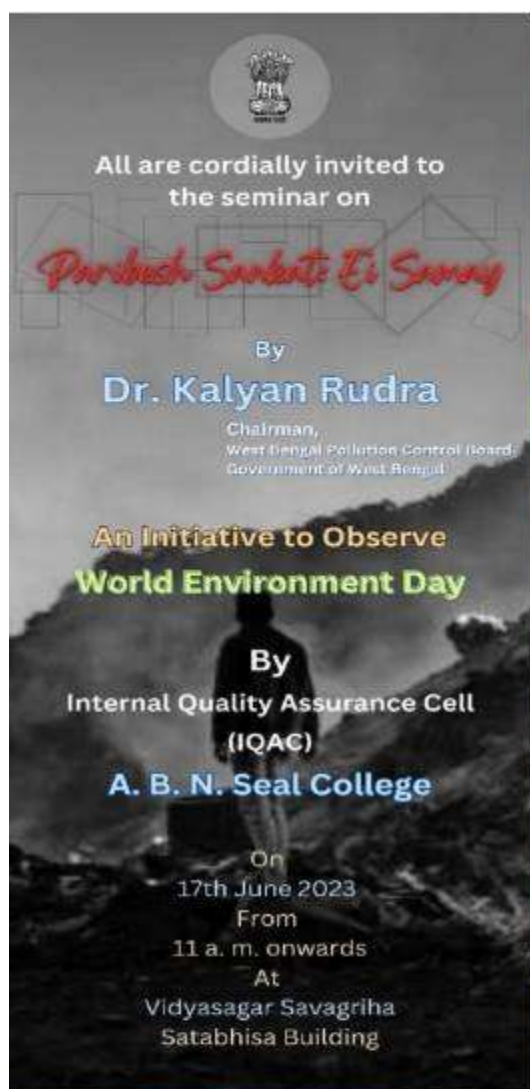

IPR has been an established policy instrument to incentivise innovation but using IP (including IPR) as a strategic tool to facilitate sustainability remains little understood. Despite the strong dependencies between IP and innovation, literature lacks an understanding of how companies should responsibly manage and use IP to govern innovations, especially technologies potentially supporting SDGs. Sustainability-oriented innovations expand the scope of innovation to include environmental as well as social and economic dimensions. However, several of these innovations involve complex intellectual property (IP) related challenges that potentially hinder their development and diffusion.

In this backdrop, a one-day webinar titled '**Managing Innovations and Sustainability Transitions: Is IPR alone sufficient?**' was organized by Department of Economics, A.B.N. Seal College on 11th May, 2023 in online mode through Google meet platform. Students and faculty members of Economics, faculty members and students of other departments of this college, faculty members, students and research scholars of other institutes attended the webinar.. The webinar commenced at 2-30 p.m., Dr.Joyjit Dhar, Head of the Department of Economics welcomed the august gathering and also the distinguished speaker of the day. Revered Principal of the College Dr. Nilay Ray inaugurated the seminar and delivered the inaugural speech. At the beginning of the technical session, Sri Partha Sarathi Aich, faculty member of the Department introduced the erudite speaker of the day Dr. Duke Ghosh. Dr. Duke Ghosh is a Fellow of The Ryoichi Sasakawa Young Leaders' Fellowship Fund (SYLFF) of the Tokyo Foundation. He is also a former WOTRO-NWO Post-Doctoral Fellow of the Netherlands at the Global Change Programme, Jadavpur University and University of Technology at Eindhoven. He has also been a Research Fellow of the Science and Policy Research Institute (SPRU) of the University of Sussex. He is currently a Partner and Lead Researcher at Global Change Research, Kolkata. As a visiting faculty, Dr. Ghosh is and/or has been teaching at the Indian Institute of Foreign Trade, Indian Institute of Management (Shillong), Indian Institute of Social Welfare and Business Management, International

Management Institute, Institute of Cost and Management Accountants, Vinod Gupta School of Management, Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur, Management Development Institute, and many other institutions. By training, Dr. Ghosh is an Economist. The research interests of Dr. Ghosh are sustainability transitions, economics of sustainable development, financial economics, small business economics, etc. Dr. Ghosh has a rich experience of providing research and consulting services to the various Governments at the national and sub-national levels, Asian Development Bank (ADB), United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO), United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), Confederation of Indian Industries (CII), Oxford Policy Management, Pricewaterhouse Coopers (PwC), Ernst & Young (E&Y), CRISIL and numerous other organizations of international repute.

The technical session started with an excellent and interactive presentation by Dr. Ghosh. His presentation began with explaining the difference between invention and innovation and how it is related with IPR. Moreover, what is patent, the different tools available for patenting were also delineated in this session. However, he pointed out that IPR is a necessary condition for protection of intellectual property it is not a sufficient one. In this context, he then invokes the role of sustainability transitions. This sustainability transitions focuses on transformative changes in sustainability gains in terms of economic, social and environmental issues. He explained using the example of 'Smart cities in India' that these changes are mostly radical based on technology and innovation which might conflict with the existing regime. Consequently, he suggested only socio-technical embedding of a few emerging technologies may outperform the regime.





Further, he analysed that it is not the technology alone there are other factors like constraints of finance of municipalities, urban sprawl of the Indian cities may inhibit upscale of technical solution. Finally, he concluded with policy response of the sustainability problem with 'Strategic Niche Management' or 'SNM'. In the end, there was a very good question-answer round which clarified many doubts of the audience regarding IPR. The workshop ended at 4 pm with the vote of thanks by Prof. Dilip Kumar Das, Associate Professor of Economics.

Outcome of the Workshop:

This webinar was a eye opener for all the participants to gain an understanding about IPR and the present scenario in our country. They were also learnt that IPR is a necessary condition for protection of intellectual property it may not be the sufficient one. Nevertheless, the importance of small innovations on societies at large and the role of patenting cannot be denied for the good of the common people of a developing economy.

A three day long workshop was jointly organised by Department of Botany, ABN Seal College, Cooch Behar and Department of Biochemistry, Uttar Banga Krishi Vishwavidyalaya, Pundibari, Cooch Behar from 6th to 8th May, 2023. The objectives of the workshop were to inculcate the basic knowledge of plant tissue culture among the students of this region and its applications. A good number of students from host institution and surrounding colleges actively participated in the workshop including hands on training on plant micropropagation techniques. A total of 47 UG students from different colleges were participated in this.

Day 1 (06/05/2023)

The inaugural session was commenced from 11:00 am in presence of Dr. Nilay Ray (Principal, ABN Seal College); Sri Chandra Sekhar Pandit (Secretary, Teachers' Council, ABNSC); Dr. Arijit Chakraborty

(Coordinator, IQAC, ABNSC); Dr. Nandita Sahana (Resource person, Department of Biochemistry, UBKV), Dr. Aninda Mandal (Head, Department of Botany, ABNSC); faculty members and students. Dr. Binod Chandra Sharma welcomed all the dignitaries and students. Dr. Nilay Ray (Principal, ABNSC) highlighted the importance of imparting hands on training programmes for the overall development of students.

Technical Session 1: Dr. Nandita Sahana discussed the history & development of plant tissue culture, various aspects & techniques, scope of micropropagation at regional as well as national level. She also highlighted on the ongoing research projects on micropropagation at UBKV. The lecture was followed by interactive session where Dr. Sahana replied to all queries made by students related to micropropagation of potato and other cash crops of the region.

Technical Session 2: Dr. Binod Chandra Sharma began the session with brief introduction on the requirements of tissue culture facility. Then the students were brought to laboratory and demonstrated the process of media preparation, sterilisation and *in vitro* inoculation.

Day 2 (07/05/2023)

Technical Session 1: Hands on training on media preparation and sterilisation techniques were imparted to all the students by Dr. Sharma. All the students actively involved themselves in the preparation of Murashige and Skoog (MS) agar medium, autoclaving and preparation of stabs.

Technical Session 2: MS medium stab, leaf explant, surface sterilants were provided to the students. Each of them inoculated the leaf explant following all the protocols using the laminar airflow cabinet available in the department. The inoculated stabs were placed inside the plant growth chamber for growth and development.

Day 3 (08/05/2023)

Institutional Visit: All the students and faculty members assembled in the college at 10:30 am and reached the Directorate Research Building of Uttar Banga Krishi Viswavidyalaya. Dr. Nandita Sahana welcomed all of us and guided to Micropropagation Room. The culture room was full of well-developed *in vitro* clonal population of banana, gerbera, cinchona, potato, citrus, mainly. The students were made aware difficulties in plant micropropagation showing the contaminated bottles. The students were also acquainted with the orientation of media preparation room and inoculation room as well as the different types instruments like laminar airflow cabinet, autoclaves, dissecting microscopes etc. Then we were guided to hardening facility and shown successfully hardened (ready to transplant) plantlets.

Conclusion: The workshop could impart the knowledge of plant micropropagation among the participants along with the hands on training. The preliminary training of tissue culture including inoculation in ABN Seal College and the observation of expected results in UBKV generated interest among the participants. They can utilise the skills learnt during the workshop leading themselves to successful and self-reliant entrepreneurs.

Future: Well established tissue culture facility may be established in the institution so that we can impart long term training to the students as well as local entrepreneurs. More works can be initiated taking endangered medicinal as well as timber plants for the conservation of biodiversity in this ethnobotanically rich region of India.

The Department of Botany, ABN Seal College, Cooch Behar has been organizing Lecture series called as AJC Bose Memorial Lecture on annual basis inviting resource persons working on the field of applied Botany. In continuation of the lecture series this academic session (2022-2023) we approached Dr. Kishore Kumar Thapa, Head, Department of Botany, Dinhata College, Dist. Cooch Behar, West Bengal and he kindly gave his consent for delivering a popular lecture entitled **"Insights into Citrus: Domestication and Cultivation"** on 12/05/2023. The students of the different Departments of the College registered themselves for the lecture at 2:30 pm on 12/05/2023 at Vidyasagar Sabhagriha (Seminar Hall) of the College. The programme started at 3:00 pm with welcome address by Dr. Binod Chandra Sharma, Associate Professor of the Department of Botany in presence of Dr. Nilay Ray (The Principal, ABNSC), Dr. Kishore Kumar Thapa (Resource person), Dr. Aninda Mandal (Head, Department of Botany, ABNSC), Sri Ajoy Das (Assistant Professor of Botany, ABNSC), Dr. Bapi Ghosh (Assistant Professor of Botany, ABNSC), Smt. Mousikha Lala (Assistant Professor of Botany, ABNSC), Smt. Jayita Debnath (SACT of Botany, ABNSC) and students from Department of Botany, Zoology, Physiology. Dr. Nilay Ray, Principal, ABN Seal College addressed the gathering highlighting the importance of holding such kind of memorial lectures in the College as a whole to aware the students on modern scientific developments and ignite their interest in the field of research. Dr. Thapa began his deliberation with brief introduction on plantation crops of North Bengal. Then he discussed the origin and distribution of citrus in the world. According the studies so far China is considered as the centre of origin of citrus. In India basically there are four cultivars of *Citrus reticulata* (mandarin orange) namely, Khasi Mandarin, Darjeeling Mandarin, Nagpur mandarin and Coorg Mandarin. In addition to these a number of different varieties of lime and lemon are cultivated and marketed in India. Dr. Thapa also highlighted on the present constrains in mandarin cultivation due to heavy loss of citrus crops owing to bacterial, fungal, viral, nematode and insect diseases. Citrus greening disease (a bacterial disease) and a viral disease caused by *Citrus tristeza* virus are the main cause of concern for Darjeeling mandarin. Dr. Thapa suggested for a proper quarantine facility and integrated disease management involving all the stakeholders. The students actively participated by placing a number of queries related to varieties and diseases of citrus and Dr. Thapa was able to convince them with appropriate examples. The lecture series ended with a vote of thanks.

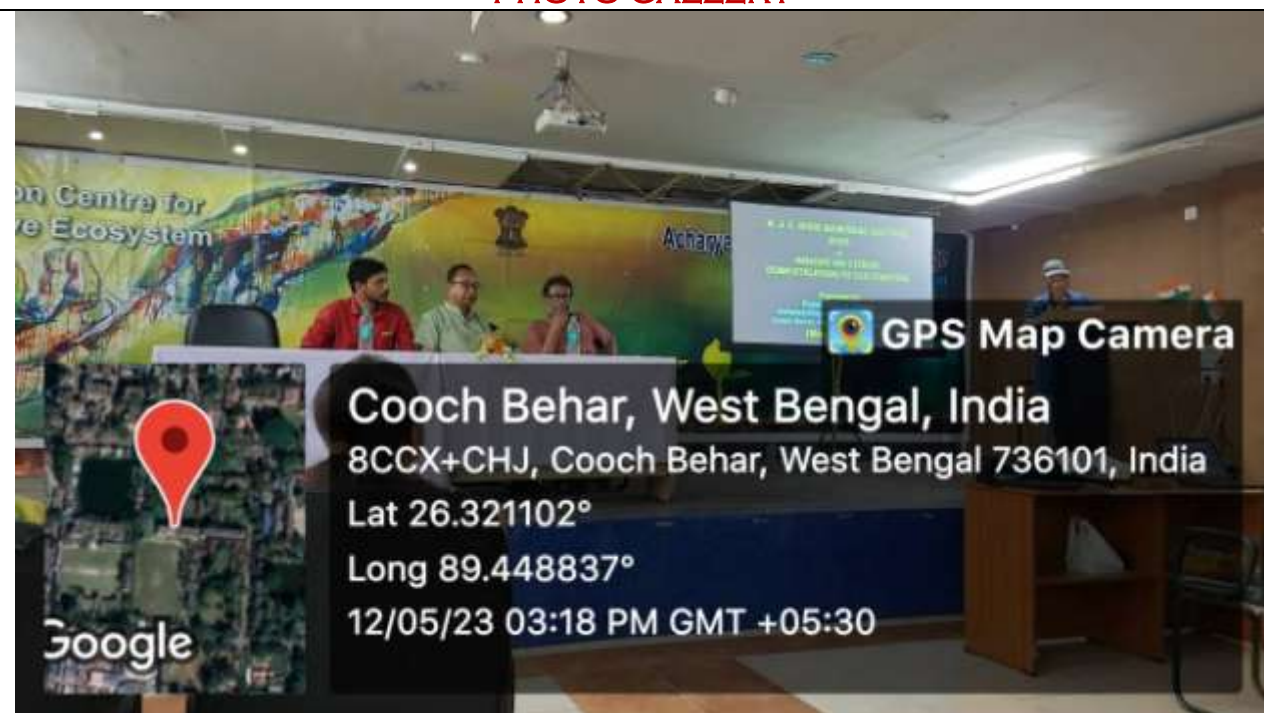


Figure 1: Welcome address by Dr. Binod C. Sharma, Associate Professor of the Department of Botany

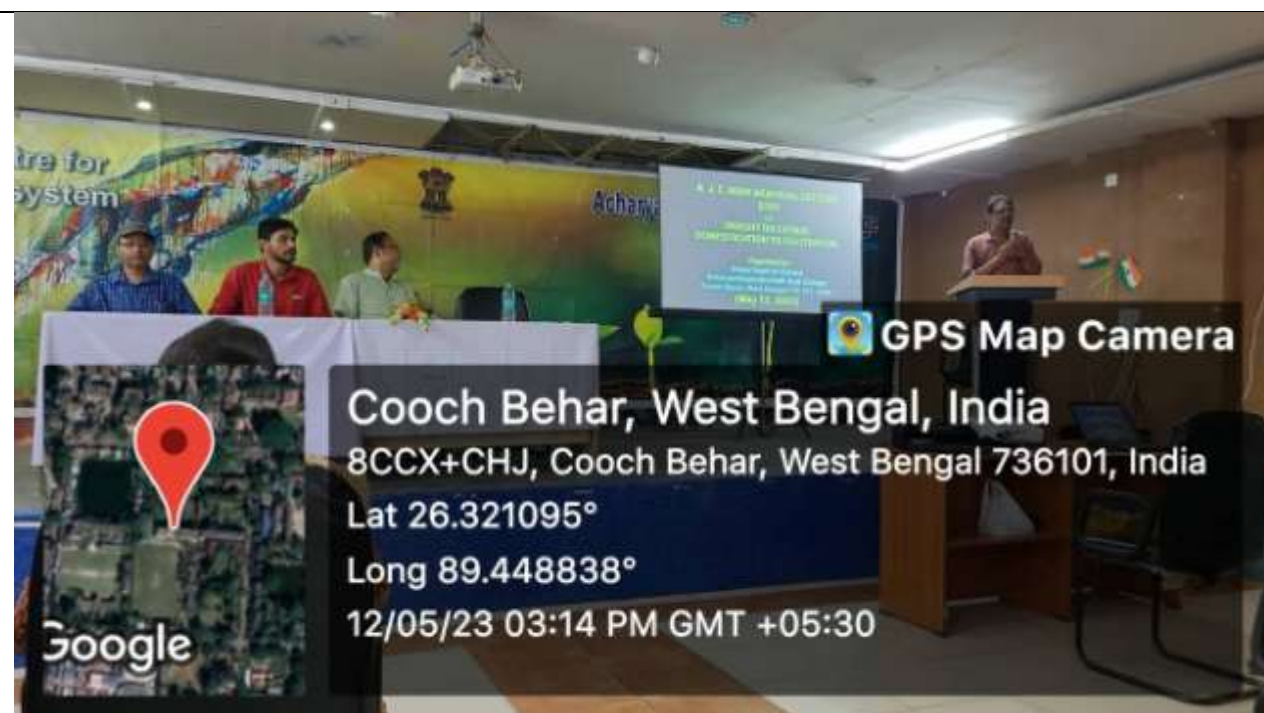


Figure 2: Dr. Nilay Ray, Principal, addressing the gathering

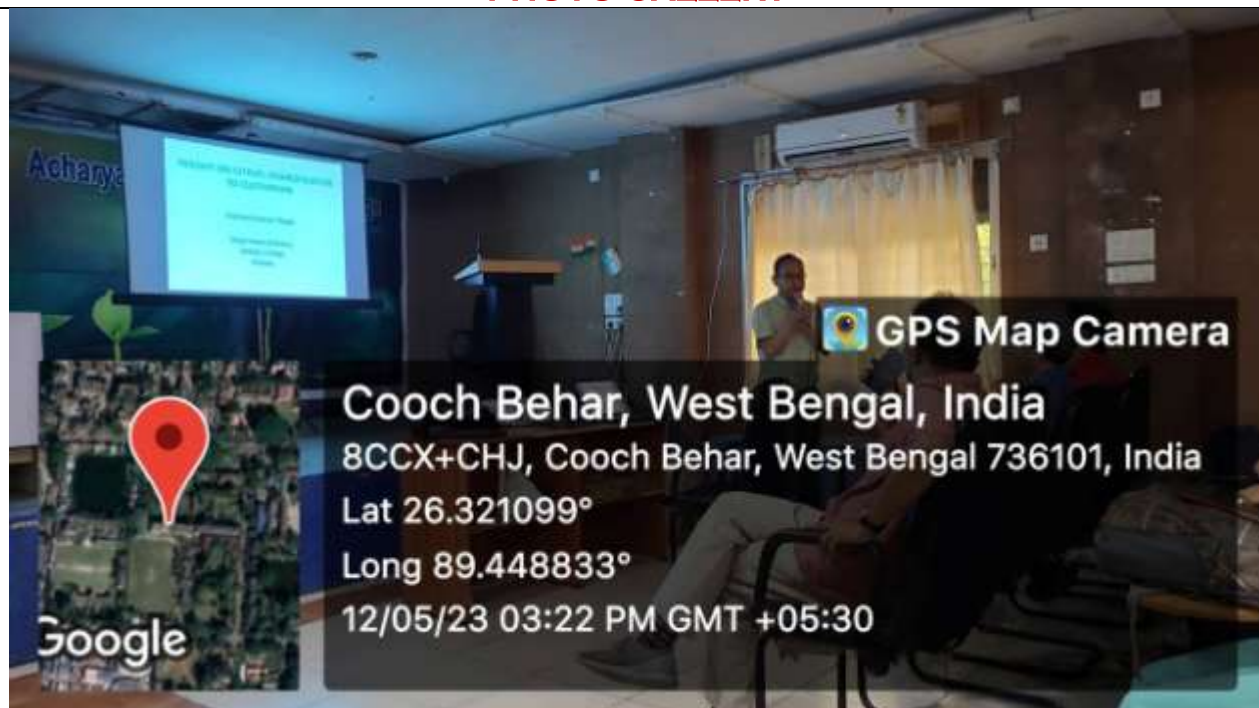


Figure 3: Dr. Thapa, Resource Person, delivering his lecture

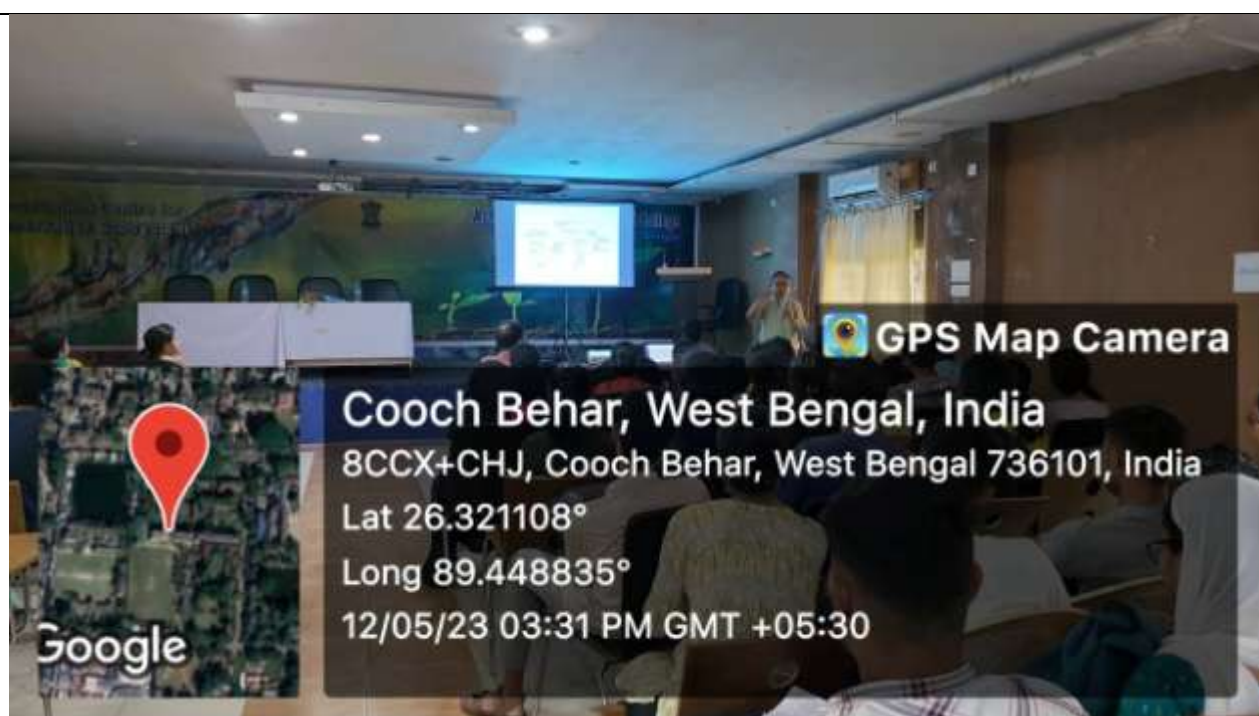


Figure 4: Dr. Thapa, Resource Person, delivering his lecture

Asima Chatterjee, a renowned Indian Chemist, was the first woman to receive a DSc degree from University of Calcutta in 1944, and becoming the first female recipient of Shree Jyoti Bhattacharya award (highest science awards in India) in the year 1961. She was also the first woman to hold the chair of any Indian University (at University of Calcutta), and also served as general president of Indian Science Congress. She made significant contributions to Medicinal Chemistry, Natural product Chemistry and Organic Chemistry, particularly in alkaloid and terpenoid. Dr. Chatterjee successfully developed several plant based medicines including anti-obesity drug 'Marsilone' and anti-malarial drug 'Apyrid-56'. She also dedicated forty years of her time to research on cancer and anti-cancer growth drugs. She also established Central Ayurveda Research Institute, Kolkata.

Special Lecture on “Human Values” and “Idealism: Philosophy of Hegel” to observe the World Philosophy Day organized by Department of Philosophy on 17.11.2022**Department of Philosophy:****1. Observation of World Philosophy Day, 2022:**

The Department of Philosophy observed the World Philosophy Day on 17/11/2022 from 11am at Vidyasagar Sabhagriha, A.B.N Seal College. Two eminent speakers, Dr. Jyotish Chandra Basak, Professor, Department of Philosophy, North Bengal University and Dr. Anureema Bhattacharyya, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Philosophy, North Bengal University had their deliberations on **“Human Values”** and **“Idealism: Philosophy of Hegel”** respectively on that occasion.

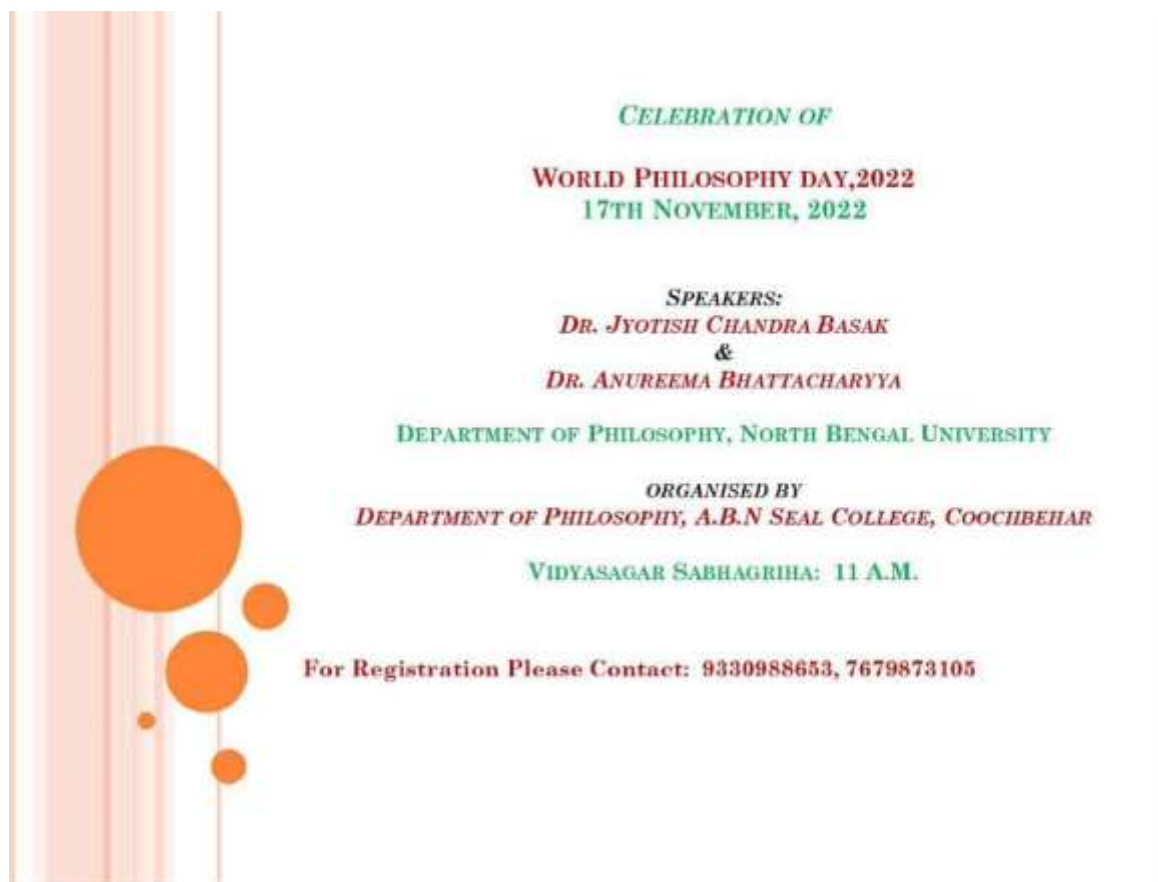
Professor Basak dealt with the concept and different approaches of human values. Human values are the convictions, standards and rules that a person adheres to as a guide for their daily activities. These values comprised of a set of behavioural norms that people choose to follow in order to uphold interpersonal relationships, seen from a social perspective. These are essential for preserving peace and stability in the society. Its nature is universal as every human being shares these values, regardless their religion, caste, creed, culture, nationality or history. The speaker then explained how culture is specifically affected by human values and how these values are implanted in different stages of human life. He opined and explained how people can better appreciate and show respect for the peaceful relationship among individuals by promoting such finer human values. Next he pointed out the relation between human values and ethical values; importance of human values in business organisations with the examples of some prominent human values like modesty, self-respect, responsibility, civility etc. Human values have taken on significant importance in our socio-economic environment in the modern era as the corporate sector continues to grow and business firms become more competitive in nature. This is necessary for the system to be able to handle complexity with peace and harmony.

The next resource person, Dr. Anureema Bhattacharyya discussed elaborately on the principles of Idealism with the special reference to the philosophy of Hegel. A form of Idealism, absolute idealism is Hegel's account of how being is ultimately comprehensible as an all-inclusive whole. Hegel asserted that in order for the thinking subject to be able to know its object, the world, at all, there must be a sense of identity, in some sense, of thought and being. Otherwise, the subject would never have an access to the object and there is no certainty about any of our knowledge of the world. The speaker showed that the unity of thought and being cannot be expressed as the abstract

identity. Absolute idealism is the attempt to demonstrate this unity using a new 'speculative' philosophical method, which requires new concepts and rules of logic. For Hegel, the absolute ground of being is essentially a dynamic, historical process of necessity that unfolds by itself in the form of increasingly complex forms of being and of consciousness, ultimately giving rise to all the diversity in the world and in the concepts with which we think and make sense of the world.

55 Students and 10 faculty members attend the lectures. Total duration was 3 hours and the session witnessed a number of queries from the audience.





Special Lecture on "Basics of Counselling: An Outline" - conducted by Department of Philosophy on 29.04.2023**2. Special Lecture---**

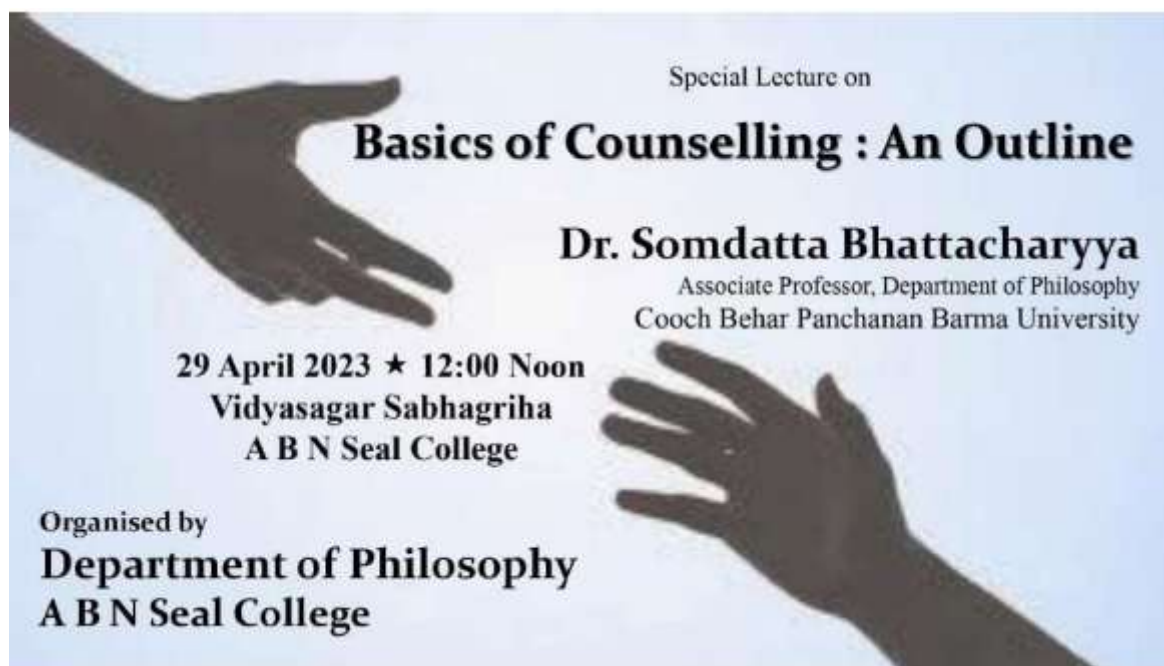
A special lecture on "Basics of Counselling: An Outline" was organised by the Department of Philosophy on 29th April, 2023 from 12 noon at Vidyasagar Sabhagriha, A.B.N Seal College. Dr. Somdatta Bhattacharyya, Associate Professor, Department of Philosophy, Cooch Behar Panchanan Barma University delivered her perceptive views on principles of counselling. After briefly discussing nature and scope of counselling she explained basic skills of counselling including nature of listening, difference between hearing and listening, the importance of listening in counselling, various types of listening i.e. Inactive, Selective and Active listening. Further she clarified with examples which are and are not counsellor's responses, definition of communication, various types of communication and assertive communication as a mode of counsellor's response.

Dr. Bhattacharyya reflected upon the process of counselling—three basic attitudes for successful therapy following Carl Roger's Client-centered therapy approach—Counsellor's genuineness or congruence, counsellor's complete acceptance or unconditional positive regard for the client, empathic understanding by the therapist of the client's feelings.

Finally, the speaker explained some principal ethical issues concerning counselling—Confidentiality and Neutrality. Her deliberation involved definition and moral dilemma centering confidentiality and neutrality.

All the participants were highly enlightened by her deliberation. 86 students and 15 faculty members attended and six from the students asked very relevant questions on the concept of Ethics involved in Counselling. Total duration of the deliberation was 3 hours.

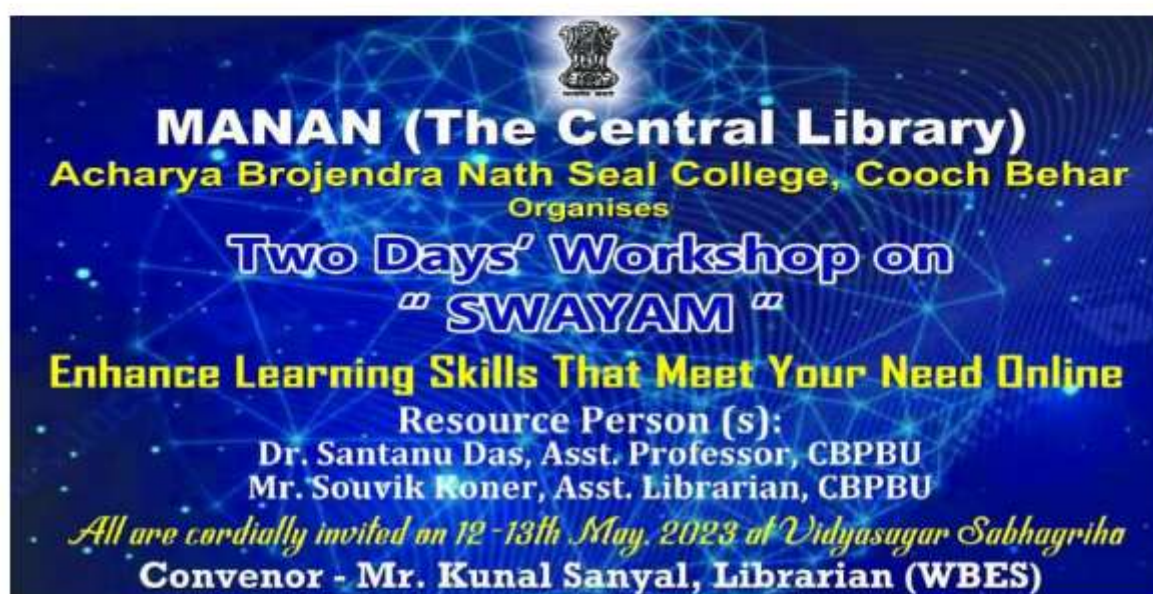
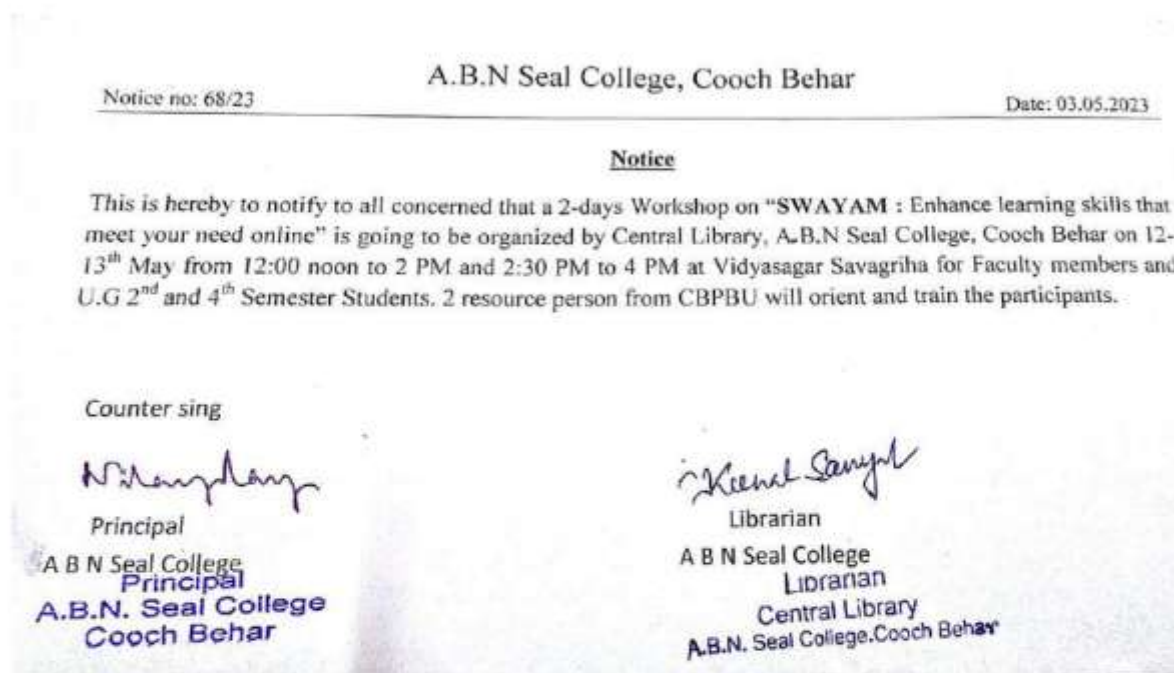
A short scenario of facilities to promote online learning environment in ABN Seal college was presented by Mr. Kunal Sanyal, Librarian, A.B.N Seal college.




