### Guidelines for contributors

The articles should be arranged in the order: Title (upper/lower; 14 font size), Authors (upper/lower; 11 font size), Address (with PIN code & e-mail id; 9 font size), Abstract (short; 9 font size), Key words (9 font size), Introduction, Methodology, Results, Discussion, Conclusion, Acknowledgements (if any), Statement on conflict of interest (if any), Declarations made on ethical issues (wherever relevant) and Literature Cited (all in 11 font size). Results may be presented either in tables or in graphs.

Tables should be generated using 'Insert Table' format in MSWORD. All tables, figures, photos, maps etc. are to be properly numbered and with proper legends/ captions and those should be referred in the text.

**References:** References in the text should be numbered inside bracket, serially in the order in which they appear. For list of references following format is to be maintained:
